- **November 3, 2026 State Election**
5pm, Saturday, October 24, 2026

Check www.VoteInMA.com to confirm your voter registration, make changes to your registration or register to vote. You must be a U.S. citizen and at least 18 years old to vote.



TO VOTE IN A PRIMARY, VOTER MUST SPECIFY THEIR CHOICE OF DEMOCRATIC OR REPUBLICAN BALLOT, BY MAIL ON APPLICATION OR IN PERSON.

VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT (VBM) APPLICATION DEADLINES:

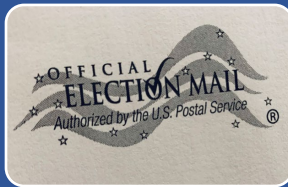

- Ballots are not forwardable! Include your mailing address



Four Ways to Submit VBM Applications (Just file once):

1. Email – Voting@belmont-ma.gov
2. Mail – Town Clerk, 455 Concord Ave, Belmont, MA 02478
3. Drop Off - Town Clerk's secure green drop box at the base of stairs to Town Hall
4. Online – www.VoteInMA.com ("Pending" status means the application was received and is being processed)
